### *Senior Forest Officer (Forest Management)*

The Senior Forest Officer (SFO) - Forest Management is responsible for the delivery of regional land based operational programs and activities across the forest estate. This position will focus on plantation establishment and management, and relevant stakeholder engagement.

- Develop and implement tactical and operational programs for the establishment and maintenance of plantations, and where required, native forest reforestation activities.
- Monitor and report on plantation programs and contractor activities.
- Participate in forest management activities including fire-fighting duties, managing invasive weeds, rubbish and illegal wood collection.
- Maintain strong, positive relationships with customers and contractors, including effective resolution of issues.
- Identify and effectively respond to emerging stakeholder and community issues and implement stakeholder engagement processes.
- Prepare and implement Forest Practices Plans, Forest Operation Plans, and other task planning.
